Aim of the workshop :

The aim of the workshop is to further develop a broad joint program between North East Romania (NER) and the Northern Netherlands (N-NLs) in the field of Research and Innovation Strategies of Smart Specialisation.

During the first very successful TAIEX events, a variety of meetings and talks and a wide exchange of views, at different institutional levels and with different types of organizations, gave SNN and NER a broad picture of the 'state of play' and potential RIS 3 cooperation.

As a logical follow up on these events, the workshop will now focus on the next steps:

- To set the operational plans for the innovation environment in Romania, connected to the Northern Netherlands innovation environment.
- To train lead-organizations and frontrunners in each value chain in the methodology for societal transition.

Concrete Goals:

Goal 1/Deliverables to be reached

- A full architecture, i.e. functional design, specification, organization and finance of an incubator as a S4 innovation environment;
- An infrastructure design for an incubator;
- A full architecture of a living lab and a living lab region as S4 innovation environments;
- An infrastructure design for both forms of living lab;
- An incentive program for incubators and living labs;
- A location proposal for incubators and living lab(s);
- At least 6 innovation environment builders, fully capacitated to build, operate, promote and manage the innovation environments.

Goal 2/ Deliverables to be reached

- At least 5 transition managers, fully capacitated to create and sustain an integral societal transition based on S4 and RIS4;
- At least 12 innovation environment frontrunners, fully capacitated to work in, to develop and to promote the innovation environments;
- A jointly created political profile of this societal transition, to inform and connect political leaders at all levels.
