BACKGROUND

Many students in higher education have cognitive problems which hinder them in successfully functioning at school. These students are therefore at risk of early school leaving.



AIM

The aim of the Move aHead project is to develop, pilot and evaluate an intervention for educational professionals to support students with cognitive problems to remain in higher education.

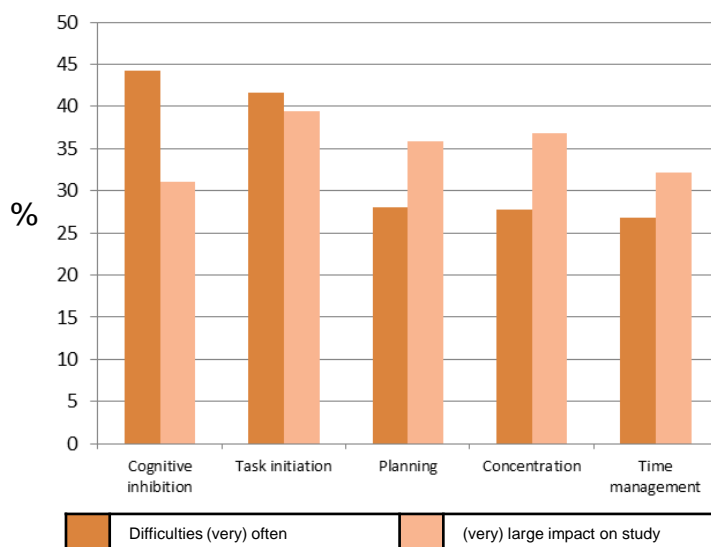


ACTIVITIES

- Survey on cognitive problems among all students of the Hanze University
- Development of an instrument to assess cognitive problems
- Development of 8-12 modules with compensating strategies
- Evaluation of the modules

FIRST RESULTS

The figure below presents the first results from the survey among students from the Hanze (n = 2732). It shows the top 5 of cognitive skills with which students experience the most difficulties.



OUTCOME

- A practical tailor-made cognitive remediation (CR) intervention
- At least 10 educational professionals have been trained in the CR-intervention
- The CR-intervention has been provided to at least 25 students
- A manual to train educational professionals
- A consultation program to support other universities
