Groningen: City of Talent

Overall aim of the Center

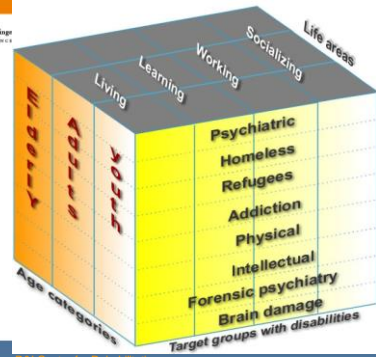


- To develop the knowledge domain of PSR in interaction with the fields of Health and Welfare, the field of science and the educational field

Undergraduate Education (bachelor):

PSR is a part of the curricula of the Schools of Social Work, Applied Psychology & Occupational Therapy

Major

- 1st year : PSR knowledge + attitude (4 Cr)
- 2nd year : PSR skills (4 Cr)
- 3d year : PSR internship (1 year)
- 4th year : PSR bachelor thesis (30 Cr)

Minor

In 3d or 4th year for students of other schools (30 Cr)
