- Complex: multisectoral, new ways of governance, teaching etc.



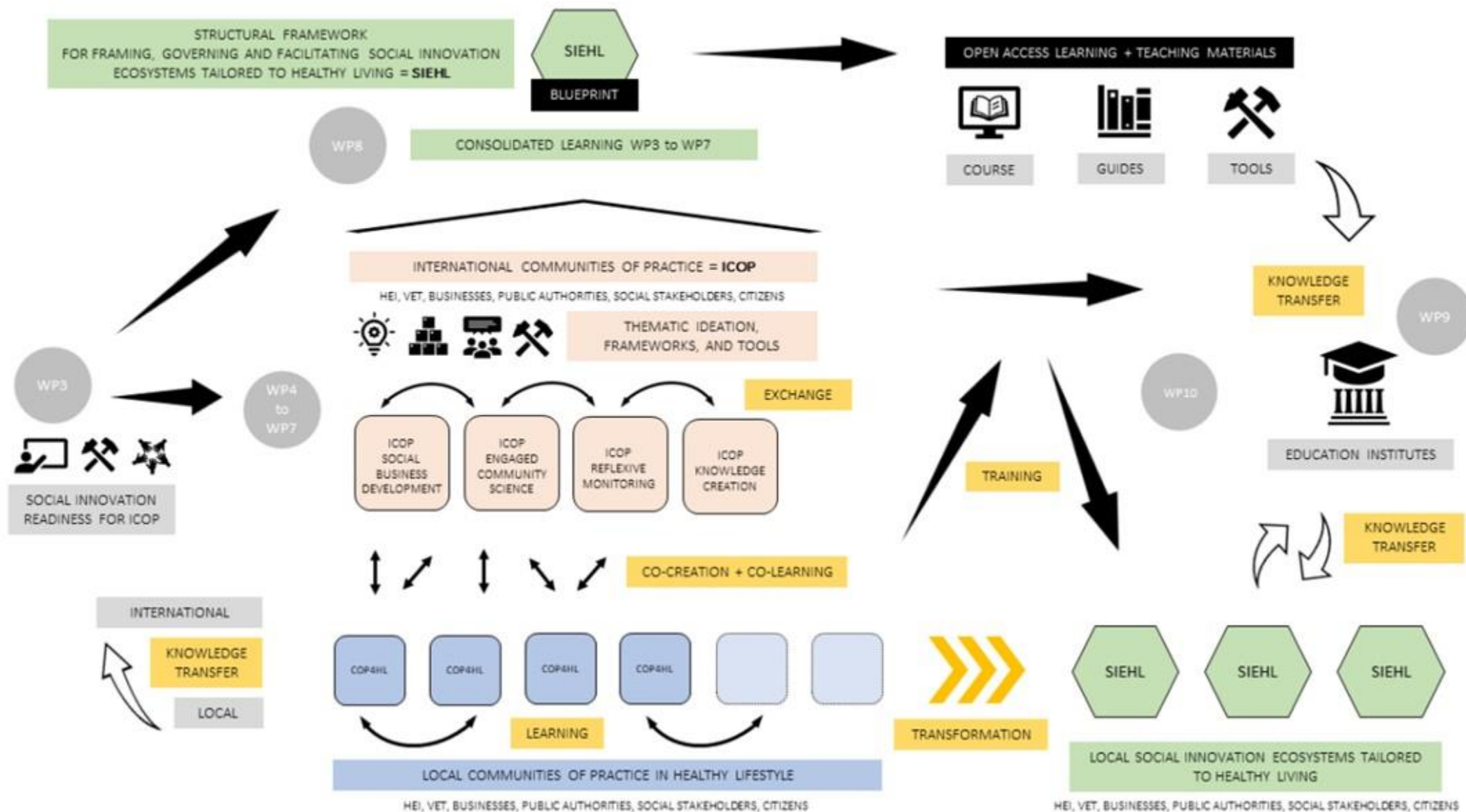
